

As a reminder, here is the policy for all White Knoll High School rehearsals:

In general, only performing members, directors, and staff are allowed to be in a rehearsal space during a scheduled rehearsal. Rehearsals are closed to any parent, family member, or friend of any performing member. Common meeting areas inside the school and outside are defined as the parking lot, hallways, bus loop, etc.

Specifically, the following are guidelines for various ensembles and their rehearsal space(s):

Marching Band: During rehearsals, only performing members, directors, and staff are allowed down on the band practice field. Only if an emergency arises, should any other person come down to the practice field. Parents, family members, or friends of any performing member may watch rehearsal from the top of the stairs.

If the marching band is rehearsing in the stadium, parents, family members, or friend of any performing member may sit in the stands to observe.

Wind Ensemble/Concert Band: During rehearsals, only performing members, directors, and staff are allowed in the band room. This space is limited in size, and is a classroom teaching environment. If the band is rehearsing in the auditorium, parents, family members, or friends of any performing member may sit in the auditorium to listen.

Winter Guard/Winter Percussion: During rehearsals, only performing members, directors, and staff are allowed in the cafeteria. Only if an emergency arises, should any other person come in the cafeteria. This is also true if any of these ensembles are in the gym, or outside at a contest.

As a courtesy, parents, family members, or friend of any performing member may come into the cafeteria during the **last 30 minutes** of rehearsal to watch the final run through. Please stay in the area on the side where the tables will be set up.
